

Navajo Nation Oil & Gas Company/Student Contract

This contract is made and entered into for the academic school year. The student is making application, by and between Navajo Nation Oil & Gas Company and the student applicant, hereinafter called the recipient.

RECEIPIENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. The recipient shall adhere to set deadlines to submit required documentation noted on (3.) (a.—g.).
 - a. If attending FALL semester, the deadline is June 30th.
 - b. If attending WINTER/SPRING Semester, the deadline is November 30th.
 - c. If attending SUMMER Semester the deadline is April 30th.
2. The recipient shall satisfy the following eligibility criteria for consideration for a NNOGC scholarship.
 - a. The recipient must be an enrolled member of the Navajo Nation and provide certification of such member.
 - b. The recipient must not be a member of the immediate family of an officer or director of NNOGC.
 - i. Immediate family includes children, parents, grandchildren, step-children, step-parents, first cousins, nephews, nieces, uncles and aunts.
 - c. The recipient must major in subject matters central of the petroleum industry.
 - i. Such as engineering (petroleum, mining, mechanical, civil, environmental, or electrical), geology, natural resource management, accounting, marketing, business administration and human resource management.
 - d. The recipient must have a Grade Point Average ("GPA") of at least 3.0 when first enrolling; and the recipient must maintain a GPA of 3.0 or higher for subsequent semesters the recipient participates in the program.
 - e. The recipient must be admitted and registered as a full-time student at an accredited educational institution.
3. The recipient shall satisfy the following required documents to be considered for a NNOGC scholarship.
 - a. Complete and sign the NNOGC Scholarship Application.
 - b. Complete and sign the NNOGC/Student Contract.
 - c. Submit a certified copy of Certificate of Indian Blood (CIB).
 - d. Letter of Interest.
 - e. Letters of Reference.
 - f. Letter of Admission/Enrollment Verification from college or university.
 - g. Official transcript (high school, college, or university).
4. The recipient shall satisfy the following required documents if they are a CONTINUING student to be considered for a NNOGC scholarship.
 - a. Enrollment Verification from college/university attending.
 - b. Official transcript after each completed semester.
 - c. Maintain GPA of at least 3.0.

NNOGC RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Human Resources Department shall act as the program coordinator to monitor recipient's eligibility requirements.
2. The program coordinator shall place a recipient on probation for a semester if requirements for (4.) (a.—c.) are not met.
3. The program coordinator shall re-evaluate the recipient's eligibility requirements at the end of the probationary semester and make a determination for further award status.
4. The program coordinator shall deem a recipient ineligible if the recipient does not meet one or more of the above terms outlined.

NNOGC Scholarship Program is designed to encourage academic excellence to prepare Navajo tribal members for leadership in the petroleum industry by providing funds to assist selected Navajo students for their educational expenses which includes tuition, fees, books, room and board.
