ESSENTIAL DUTIES, FUNCTIONS & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Perform daily pre-trip/post-trip vehicle and equipment inspections.
- Perform basic vehicle maintenance (minor repairs, fueling, oil, fluids, tire pressures, lights, etc.).
- Maintain logs in accordance with DOT requirements.
- Maintain vehicles, and other associated equipment, in a clean and orderly manner.
- Safely perform loading and unloading propane bobtail operations in accordance with NFPA 58 and company policies and procedures.
- Professionally represent the company in interaction with employees, contractors, customers, residents, and law enforcement and regulatory authorities.
- Develop constructive and cooperative working relationships among employees and other staff and maintain them overtime.
- Promote and enforce all company policies and procedures.

MINIMUM MANDATORY QUALIFICATIONS

License and Certifications:

- Minimum of CDL Class B required with 2+ years of experience
- Tank & Hazmat (X) endorsement preferred
- Propane Education & Research Council (PERC) Certified Employee Training Program (CETP) preferred

Experience:

- Minimum of 2 consecutive years' proven experience transporting bulk fluids in commercial cargo tanks.
- Propane delivery experience preferred

Education:

- High School Diploma or equivalent.

- Possess a valid Class A or B commercial driver's license with hazmat / tanker endorsement.
- Possess a current DOT medical card with no physical limitations or restrictions.
